NIDCC is defined as specialized body of the MOH concerning the infectious diseases prevention and control and which is responsible for putting the policy and strategy and planning in the fight against communicable diseases in collaboration with NGOs and International organizations. Respect to the center to collect the raw data, and conduct field surveys and follow-up of diseases and communications received them from hospitals and centers and primary health care units, and study aimed at finding practical ways of prevention and control.

NIDCC consists of:- 5 administrations: administrative and financial affairs administration, management research and development administration, tuberculosis and chest diseases administration, communicable disease control administration, HIV/AIDS and sexual transmitted diseases control administration. There are also 26 NIDCC centers distributed in the country.

HIV/AIDS administration includes three units: - Planning, Monitoring & Evaluation unit -awareness and educational unit-therapeutic unit. HIV/AIDS department have direct communication with national surveillance programme and other administrations in NIDCC.

The National Surveillance Programme (NSP) is one of the three departments in communicable diseases control administration, which is responsible for 45 infectious diseases subject to compulsory registration, notification and reporting to NIDCC.

FETP training has still not started in Libyan National Center For Infectious Diseases Prevention And Control.

Under responsibility of communicable disease control directorate.

Parasites and vector borne diseases control department is one of three departments in the communicable disease control directorate. They are conducting major control programmes like Leishmaniasis NCP, schistosomiasis, hydatosis, toxoplasmosis & rollback malaria. In addition to that, plague & rickettesia control and other programs.
