


Objective

- 16 Training Modules for 57 Regional Labs (440 participants) on:
- Emerging arboviruses
- Emerging respiratory viruses
- Biosafety
- Future target viruses and hemorrhagic fevers



Field Epidemiology

Public Health Institutes

- 32 Training Sessions for 19 Public Health Institutes (650 participants) on field epidemiology:
- Senior specialists, Train the trainers
- Junior specialists
- Specific modules: Ebola, CBRN etc

- Trainings




Results achieved

- Creation of an environment able to address specific global and <u>trans-regional threats</u>




Capacity building 2010-2013 & 2014-2017
