The second case reported in Fayium governorate was: • A 31 years old male • Onset of symptoms 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012 • He is still in critical conditions. To date, 159 cases have been reported, including 55 deaths. The last human A(H5N1) case in Egypt was reported in AI Minufiyah on 25<sup>th</sup> December 2011 (cf. eWEB n° 197). INDONESIA Map 3. Jakarta province, Indonesia On 19<sup>th</sup> January 2012, the Ministry of health of Indonesia reported to WHO a human case of A(H5N1) in Jakarta province (cf. map 3). The case was: • A 5 years old girl Diagnosed on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2012; She died on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2012. She was a family contact of the last case reported on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2012 (cf. eWEB n° 199) in Jakarta. Common exposure to the same Jakarta contaminated pigeons has been documented.
