Comments

- On 18 December 2012, Egyptian health authorities reported to [WHO](#) one new human case of A(H5N1) influenza in Damietta governorate, in Egypt (cf. map 1).
- The case was:
 - A 2 years old girl
 - With onset of symptoms on 3 December 2012
 - The case was hospitalized
 - Exposure to poultry was documented
- To date, a total of 169 cases has been confirmed in Egypt, including 60 deaths.
- The last reported case in Egypt dated 7 June 2012 in Kafr-El-Sheikh governorate (cf. [eWEB n° 221](#)).

Event: A(H5N1) –Human

Comments

- On 18 December 2012, Indonesian health authorities reported to [WHO](#) one new human case of A(H5N1) influenza in West Java, Indonesia (cf. map 2).
- The case was:
 - A 4 years old boy
 - With onset of symptoms on 30 November 2012
 - The case was hospitalized on 5 December and died on 6 December 2012
 - Exposure to poultry was documented
- To date, a total of 192 cases has been confirmed in Indonesia, including 160 deaths.
- The last reported case in Indonesia was on 10 August 2012 in Yogyakarta province.
